

On March 3rd 2013 the European Union Timber Regulation 995/2010 came into force. The Regulation prohibits the placing on EU market illegally harvested timber and timber products and requires EU traders who place timber products on the EU market for the first time to exercise "due diligence".

Tabu always put the utmost care in selecting its supplies from certified and legal sources; hence right from the start of application of EUTR, Tabu fully complies with its requests; moreover Tabu is member of the Consorzio Servizi Legno/Sughero an independent organization sponsored by the Italian Ministry of Agriculture certifying that timber used by its member complies with the strictest transparency guidelines.

As importing Operator of timber or timber products into the EU Territory, Tabu, acting in accordance to the European law, will guarantee its customer to offer legal born wood product; any Trader /Customer sourcing timber or timber products from Tabu is therefore released from any responsibilities as set by the Timber Regulation 995/2010.
